Reminder that only grass clippings, tree or shrub limbs and leaves are allowed in the brush pile.


NO— Lumber, Garbage, bags, concrete, furniture or railroad ties.

YES! You can drive your Registered Golf Car/ATV/UTV on City Streets! (but NOT the Trails or Sidewalks)

(ORD2016-24 & ORD2008-12)

All golf cars operating within the city limits must be registered with the City of Hickman.

# **Basic Rules**

- \*Cannot be parked or driven on any city trail or sidewalk.
- \*Operated only between the hours of sunrise to sunset.
- \*Vehicle must be equipped with a bicycle flag.
- \*Must be operated by persons with a valid Class O operators license.
- \*City issued registration sticker must be displayed on the rear of vehicle.
