**On behalf of the Hickman Rural Fire Department and Hickman Public Works
Department: Please Keep Fire Hydrants Clear of Obstruction**

City Code SECTION 8-108: FIRES; OBSTRUCTION OF HYDRANT It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the use of a fire hydrant or to have or place any material within 15 feet of the said hydrant. Any vehicle or material found as an obstruction may be immediately removed by the fire chief or any member of the Fire Department, at the risk, cost, and expense of the owner or claimant. (Neb. Rev. Stat. §39- 672)

Brush Facility Keys

Brush Facility Keys are available for check out from the City Office from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. The facility is for residents living within the Hickman City limits only. **Keys can be checked out overnight and returned to the City Office drop box or returned to the front desk within 24 hours.**

The Brush Pile Facility is limited to disposal of the following items:

- Tree Limbs
- Leaves
- Shrubs
- Grass Clippings

Make sure you do not bring **any** trash, lumber, or bags into the facility. Lost keys are subject to a \$25.00 replacement fee. Please continue to use this space properly as this is a great amenity that the City offers and allows for the continuation of the permit through Lincoln Lancaster County Health Department.

Hickman Recycling Facility

The City's Recycling Facility is located in Hickman's Main Park (2nd Street west of the Railroad Tracks) near the brush pile entrance.

Accepted recyclable items include:

- Tin and Aluminum Cans
- Plastics - #1 through # 5
- Newspapers/ Mixed Paper/Cardboard
- All Glass - Clear or Colored

The City of Hickman is currently working with Lancaster County to expand our Recycling Facility.
