Golf Car, ATV, & UTV Safety Reminder:

- Golf Cars, ATVs, or UTVs may not be driven on city sidewalks or trails.
- OPERATORS MUST HAVE A VALID CLASS 0 OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR FARM PERMIT.
- May only be operated between the hours of sunrise and sunset.
- Must have liability insurance coverage.
- Must be registered annually through the City of Hickman with registration sticker visible on the back of the vehicle.

ARE YOUR GOLF CARS, ATVS, AND UTVS REGISTERED FOR 2026?

The annual registration fee is \$25.00 each. All registrations expire on December 31st of each year. Proof of insurance must be provided with your registration application. Applications can be obtained at City Hall or on our website under City Services.

Attention Hickman Dog Owners



All dog licenses expire on March 31st of each year.

License fee of \$10 each for the first two dogs. Additional dogs are \$50 each.
