Propane lines from

house/building.

piping.

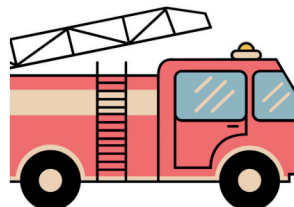

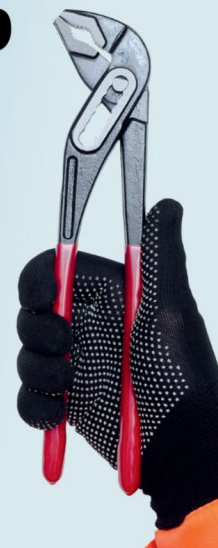
