PRIVATE UTILITY LINES ARE NOT LOCATED WHEN NEBRASKA 811 (CALL BEFORE YOU DIG) IS CONTACTED.

**Examples of Private Utilities are:** 



Underground sewer lines between the City's main and the house/building.



Underground water pipes between the City's main and the house/building.



Underground
electrical wires
between the City's
main and the
house/building.



Invisible pet fence wires.



Propane lines from the tank to the house/building.



Propane or other lines going to fire pits, BBQs, pool heaters, etc.



Lawn sprinkler piping.
